The Caribbean Sea A Tourist Destination for Over 500 Years

The first tourist in the Caribbean wrote a letter about his trip. In it he said, "I saw so many islands that I could hardly decide which to visit first."

The tourist was Christopher Columbus. The letter was to Queen Isabella of Spain. The year was 1492.

Tourists are still trying to decide, over 500 years later. The Caribbean Sea is surrounded by over 7,000 islands, varying in size from Cuba's massive 42,800 square miles, to little more than a piece of coral piercing the surface of the water in the Lesser Antilles.

Covering over one million square miles, the Caribbean Sea is bordered on the north by the Greater Antilles (Cuba, Haiti/Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, Jamaica and the Cayman Islands), on the east by the Lesser Antilles (the Virgin, Leeward, Windward and Grenadine

Islands), on the south by the Dutch Leeward Islands (the ABCs of Aruba, Bonaire and Curaçao), Venezuela and Colombia, and on the west by the Yucatán Peninsula (Mexico and Belize) and Central America.

This sea is almost completely land-locked, either by the coasts of the major continents to its north, west, and south, or by strings of islands, no two of which are more than 90 miles apart, along the perimeter. The widest inlet to the Caribbean is the Yucatán Channel south of the Gulf of Mexico, measuring a scant 130 miles between the Yucatán Peninsula and the western tip of Cuba.

In only one other sea – the Mediterranean – do the waters lap the beaches of so many different and diverse lands and islands, ruled by so many governments. But whatever the name, history or political structure, all the Caribbean Islands share a year-round moderate tropical

climate, palm trees swaying in soothing tradewinds and sea breezes, plus almost constant sunshine warming miles of picture postcard-perfect white sand beaches.

Columbus and the Caribs

Historians disagree on the exact site of Columbus' first landing. Various theorists place him on San Salvador (then called Guanahani) or the Samana Cay in the southern Bahamas (technically not even in the Caribbean, and certainly not "America" as we have come to know it), on Antigua, St. Croix or Barbados.

Regardless of the specific island, Columbus encountered unsuspecting but friendly natives of the Arawak tribe, originally from Venezuela, and the ferocious, cannibalistic Carib Indians who were more predominant throughout the islands.

Columbus thought he had reached Asia; he called his island discoveries The West Indies. He assigned several other names to the islands of the New World: The Antilles (based on a legendary island called Antilia, supposedly a refuge for Christians fleeing Spain when the Moors invaded), the Virgin Islands (originally Las Virgenes, for the 4th century Saint Ursula and 11,000 virgins said to have been killed by the Huns), Tortola ("turtle dove," after the majority of inhabitants) and Virgin Gorda (literally "fat virgin," presumably named for the shape of the island, and not for a zaftig native maiden he may have encountered).

The all-encompassing Caribbean was named for the Carib Indians, then the most powerful and prominent inhabitants. Caribe is Spanish for "cannibal;" the English Carib refers to those ferocious, cannibalistic strong men who had all but eliminated the Arawaks and controlled the islands that Columbus "discovered."

Riches and Beaches

Columbus' four voyages to the Caribbean area were soon followed by the Spanish conquistadors, hungry for gold and other treasures of the Antilles. All the islands belonged to Spain until the mid-17th century when assorted other Western European nations were lured

by the riches, and presumably by the tropical climes. The British, French, Danes, Swedes and Dutch fought off Spain – and each other – in the ensuing 300-year colonization frenzy.

Each of the new landowners established gold, silver and copper mines, plus sugar and cotton plantations. The labor force for these ventures at first included the native Arawaks and Caribs, but after the Spanish enslaved, brutalized and all but wiped out the locals, Africans were imported.

Even before the end of slavery in the United States, the Africans revolted, and by 1840 took their dominant place among the free Caribbean people. With the U.S. military intervention during the Spanish-American War, along with some direct land purchases – the U.S. bought its 50 Virgin Islands, including St. Thomas, St. Croix and St. John, for \$25 million in 1917 – America joined the six other nations already ensconced in the Caribbean.

Nowhere on the planet is there a more varied and unique mixture of cultures, languages, races, colors, creeds, architecture, arts, entertainment, flora, fauna, fish and food than throughout the Caribbean. The weather is the common denominator, yet it is the sea itself with its crystal-clear waters that invites year-round scuba divers, snorkelers and swimmers to breathtaking beaches on each of the 50 most populated and popular islands. Other water sports abound: deep-sea fishing, sailing, wind-surfing and water-skiing are all considered some of the best in the world. In waters that average 80°, it's no wonder.

And Just How IS it Pronounced?

There are two acceptable pronunciations: care-ih-BEE-un, or kuh-RIB-ee-yun. Most Americans choose the latter and most Europeans the former. But considering the source – the native Indians of a tribe called Carib (pronounced CARE-ib, not kuh-RIB) – the former seems more accurate, although either (ee-ther or eye-ther?) is correct.

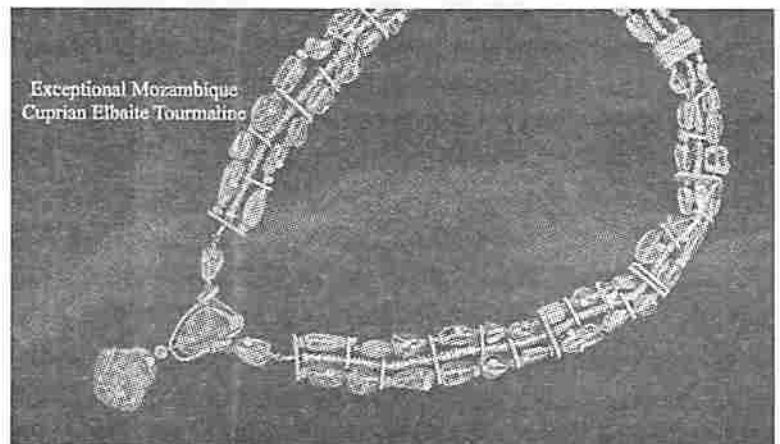

It is Crystal Cruises' wish to ensure a smooth disembarkation for all of our guests. Due to the necessity of planning for transportation, we would like to take this opportunity to ask for your assistance in finalizing your disembarkation arrangements for **Miami, Florida, USA, on Sunday, December 1, 2019.**

For those of our guests travelling independently and who have not booked transfers with Crystal Cruises, we are pleased to offer the following transfer options for Miami:

- For guests flying out of **Miami International Airport (MIA) BEFORE 2:30pm** there is a direct transfer, including porter service and staff assistance for US \$35.00 per person.
- For guests flying out of **Miami International Airport (MIA) AFTER 2:30pm**, we offer a transfer which includes a hospitality venue, porter service and staff assistance for US \$35.00 per person.
- For guests flying out of **Fort Lauderdale Airport (FLL) BEFORE 2:30pm** there is a **complimentary** direct transfer, including porter service and staff assistance.
- For guests flying out of **Fort Lauderdale Airport (FLL) AFTER 2:30pm**, we offer a **complimentary** transfer, which includes a hospitality venue, porter service and staff assistance.
- For those guests with independent arrangements in **Fort Lauderdale**, we offer a **complimentary** city center transfer to downtown Fort Lauderdale with a drop-off at the **Embassy Suites by Hilton**.

In addition, various private transfer options are available through the ship's Concierge Desk. If you do wish to participate in one of these transfer options or have any general queries in regards to disembarkation, please contact the Concierge Desk or Reception Desk located in the Crystal Plaza, Crystal Deck 5.

Kindly advise the Reception Desk **no later than, Thursday, November 28, 2019, by 12 Noon** should you wish to utilize Crystal Cruises transfer service.

We ask you to present your flight information when booking the transfer.

Early Disembarkation Requests

Guests with early independent disembarkation arrangements **between 7:30am and 8:30am** are instructed to keep their luggage inside of their staterooms and are required to carry their own luggage ashore.

Please note that the Porter Union further prevents Crystal Symphony's staff and crew from assisting guests with their luggage beyond the ship's gangway.

If you intend to disembark **between 7:30am and 8:30am** in Miami, kindly advise the Reception Desk on Crystal Deck 5 Midship no later than **Thursday, November 28, 2019, by 12 Noon**. You will be assigned to the early disembarkation group (**RED 2**).

Credit Card Pre-authorization

Please note if you have registered a credit card prior to boarding or during the check-in procedures, you are automatically registered for Express Checkout.

As a part of the Express Checkout, a pre-authorization will be run on your credit card. This pre-authorization will cover the value of your anticipated onboard spending or a minimum authorization value of \$1 USD (whichever is greater at the time of pre-authorization and which will be removed once your actual onboard spending has been finalized). Some credit card companies will notify you of this pre-authorization.

Please note that this is a pre-authorization only, no charges will be applied to your credit card apart from your actual expenses. At the end of the cruise you will receive your shipboard folio statement, showing a zero balance, reflecting your actual spending on board.

Any guest disembarking in **Miami** who wishes to change their credit card on file for their final shipboard account folio is kindly asked to do so **no later than, Thursday, November 28.**

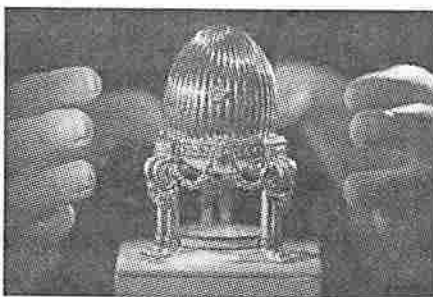
