Key West, Florida Haven for Artists and the World Weary

Situated 150 miles south of Miami, and just 90 miles north of Havana, Cuba, the tropical island city of Key West was originally called Cayo Hueso (Bone Key) in honor of Indian skeletons the Spaniards found on its shores when they first landed here in the 16th century.

The name was eventually Americanized to Key West which does not, in fact, have anything to do with the fact that this



is the westernmost of the Florida Keys. (It's not. The Marquesas and Boca Grande Keys lie a few miles further west.)

Key West also lost out on another geographical distinction in 1958 when Hawaiian statehood eliminated Key West's earlier claim as the southernmost tip of the United States. Of course, huge markers, signs and T-shirt stands still boast the Southernmost Point at the foot of Whitehead Street, although this, too, is incorrect. The real southernmost tip of Key West and the continental U.S. is actually on the navy base a few hundred feet beyond the fence to the right.

In spite of this geographical nitpicking, Key West remains a unique haven for the world-weary, with its charming array of 19th century architecture, its average 80° balmy weather and its easily-traversed streets lined with fine restaurants, galleries, shops, museums,

theatres, nightclubs and a host of historical sites. This crown jewel of the island chain Keys was largely spared from recent hurricanes, with its characteristic vibrancy and charm still very much open for business.

Mecca for Artists

Key West was heavily promoted as a tourist destination in the early '30s, and Easterners disenchanted with Miami began to take the comfortable trans-keys railroad to the remote, southernmost island. A 1935 Labor Day hurricane wiped out the railroad, and until the Overseas Highway opened three years later, the only in and out of Key West was by boat.

Intrigued with its inaccessibility, famous artists, writers and movie moguls adopted Key West as their new-found haven. Ernest Hemingway had moved here in 1931, and word quickly spread among his international family of friends that this was as close to nirvana as anyone had discovered in the continental U.S.

In the late '40s, Tennessee Williams moved here (and remained a resident until his death in 1983), James Audubon and Robert Frost lived here, and President Truman vacationed here as often as his job would allow.

Seeing the Sites

Key West is filled with fascinating historical sites, and the best way to see most of them is to board the famous Conch Train for a quick tour around the island with some expert local (and colorful) commentary by the guides. There is also a trolley which goes almost everywhere in Key West, and for a flat fee, you may take the trolley, get off at any of the many stops, then re-board the next car (they run every half-hour), then continue your self-guided tour of the eight-square-mile island until you have come full circle.

A short walk from the pier is Mallory Square, the center of "downtown" Key West. From the Square (Front and Duval Streets), you can walk to several of the key points of interest, among them the

Aquarium, the Mel Fisher Museum and the Audubon House.

The Key West Aquarium houses several hundred species of brightly colored creatures from the area, as well as a touch tank which allows you to handle conchs, crabs and sea cucumbers. The shark presentations are particularly fascinating.

Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society Museum is a must-see for anyone interested in artifacts of shipwrecks, pirate days and maritime history; there is a nominal admission charge.

Across Whitehead Street is Audubon House and Gardens, the 1840s dwelling commemorating naturalist John James Audubon. The museum is filled with antiques, and some rare old lithographs of American birds, wildlife and foliage.

Hemingway House

A few blocks south on Whitehead Street is the home that writer Ernest Hemingway bought in 1931, and where he wrote the bulk of his work (including "For Whom the Bell Tolls," "A Farewell to Arms," and "The Snows of Kilimanjaro"). The house is now a museum dedicated to the author's life, with many of his personal treasures including a ceramic cat by Pablo Picasso (a gift to the writer from the artist) and a hand-blown glass chandelier Hemingway acquired in Venice.

The large grounds' gardens are also home to over 42 – one for each of the Keys' bridges – all said to be descendants of Hemingway's own 50 cats. (Most have six toes, a result of years of in-breeding.) The admission charge is well worth it, especially if you take one of the 40-minute guided tours, rich in anecdotes of Hemingway history.

Art and Shopping

Visitors agree that in addition to its varied sights and sites, Key West offers some good shopping opportunities alongside some of the finest and most plentiful art galleries in the south. Ever since Audubon came here in 1832, artists have flocked to the Keys, and the better ones have made the area a flour-

ishing art capital. Most of the galleries and shops are within walking distance of the ship's pier and Mallory Square.

An easy stroll around this New Orleans-like town will put you in the center of the art and shopping areas.

Diving and Dining

Some of the most beautiful reefs surround Key West, offering snorkelers and divers a colorful array of underwater spectacle. Beaches are mostly man-made here; some of the best are Higgs, Smathers, Zachary Taylor and at the grand Casa Marina Resort. Dining possibilities are endless, with the local conch fish being a favorite must-try delicacy.

And do treat yourself to the almost bohemian and decidedly youthful atmosphere of one of the few truly tropical island paradises within the continental United States.

Key West, Florida Arrival Information

Crystal Symphony is scheduled to dock at Navy Mole Pier, in Key West at 7:00am today, Saturday, November 30, 2019.

A mandatory U.S. CBP inspection takes place upon our arrival at Key West. Please refer to the letter sent to your stateroom for reporting instructions.

When going ashore, please remember to carry your **Guest Identification Key Card**, as you must show it to the Security Officer when leaving and reboarding Crystal Symphony. In addition, guests must also carry a **Government Issued Photo I.D.**

As walking is not permitted in the port area, the port of Key West operates a complimentary shuttle service from the pier to Conch Tour Train Station at 501 Front Street in downtown Key West, approximately 1 mile from the pier. The shuttle will operate on a continuous basis. Bikes are NOT allowed off the ship on the Navy Mole Pier. Passengers may NOT take photos of the Navy Mole Pier Facility - this is an active Navy Facility. **The last return shuttle to the ship will depart at 4:00pm.**

U.S Customs and Border Protection - Agricultural Declaration:
To prevent the entry of dangerous agricultural pests and diseases into the United States, you must declare all agricultural and animal products. These include fruits, vegetables, seeds, live plants, plant products, meat, meat products, birds, snails and live animals. The failure to declare such products can result in their seizure and forfeiture, as well as fines and other penalties.

What is this Beaufort Scale?

Almost every morning at sea, the Captain announces the wind is currently number something-or-other on the **Beaufort Scale**. What is that?

In 1858, British admiral, mariner, and amateur meteorologist Sir Francis Beaufort invented a scale in which the force of the wind is indicated by numbers from 0 to 12:

Beaufort Number	Name	Miles Per Hour	Knots	Description of Sea Criterion
0	Calm	less than 1	less than 1	Sea like a mirror.
1	Light Air	1 to 3	1 to 3	Ripples with the appearance of scales are formed; without foam crests.
2	Light Breeze	4 to 7	4 to 6	Small wavelets, short but more pronounced; crests have glassy appearance and do not break.
3	Gentle Breeze	8 to 12	7 to 10	Large wavelets; crests begin to break; foam of glassy appearance; scattered white "horses" (foamy-topped breaking wavelets).
4	Moderate Breeze	13 to 18	11 to 16	Small waves, becoming longer; fairly frequent white horses.
5	Fresh Breeze	19 to 24	17 to 21	Moderate waves; many white horses; chance of some spray.
6	Strong Breeze	25 to 31	22 to 27	Large waves begin to form; the white foam crests are more extensive everywhere; probably some spray.
7	Near Gale (<i>or</i> Moderate Gale)	32 to 38	28 to 33	Sea heaps up and the white foam from breaking waves begins to be blown in streaks along the direction of the wind.
8	Gale (<i>or</i> Fresh Gale)	39 to 46	34 to 40	Moderately high waves of greater length; edges of crests begin to break into spindrift; foam blows in well-marked streaks.
9	Strong Gale	47 to 54	41 to 47	High waves; dense streaks of foam; crests of waves begin to tumble and roll over.
10	Storm (<i>or</i> Whole Gale)	55 to 63	48 to 55	Very high waves with long overhanging crests; resulting foam is blown in dense white streaks; surface of sea is foam-white.
11	Violent Storm	64 to 72	56 to 63	Exceptionally high waves; sea is completely covered with long white patches of foam; everywhere the edges of the crests are blown into froth; visibility is gravely affected.
